The Role of a Maid of Honour



- ❖ Runs errands during the engagement and on the wedding day as needed.
- ❖ Pays for her own attire, attends all fittings.
- ❖ May help with bachelorette party and/or a bridal shower.
- ❖ May be required to say speech at wedding reception.
- ❖ Gives gift to wedding couple.
- ❖ Attends the wedding rehearsal to get familiarized with the wedding ceremony proceedings and seating arrangements.
- ❖ Attend the rehearsal dinner.
- ❖ Arrive at the church at approximately one hour before ceremony.
- ❖ Is ready for photographer at least 2 hours before wedding ceremony.
- ❖ Carries a bouquet of flowers during wedding ceremony.
- ❖ Has pictures taken with wedding party.
- ❖ May be required to stand in receiving line.
- ❖ Sits at head table at the wedding reception.
- ❖ Help with set-up and decorating if needed.
- ❖ Help with clean up after the wedding reception if needed.
- ❖ Is Escorted by Usher you are partnered with throughout the ceremony and wedding day as needed. Dance with this partner at the wedding reception during the song for the wedding party.
- ❖ Helps the Bride and Groom wherever needed before during and after wedding day.
- ❖ Have a great time.
